The Film Festival will be held in the Round House at the Rutgers Cook Campus Farm as an afternoon session of the Junior Breeder Livestock Symposium. To participate in the film festival, you must register for the Junior Breeder Livestock Symposium. Registration form will be available at <http://nj4h.rutgers.edu/animals> in early 2023.

Youth created videos are due March 6

Entries must:

1. be educational – must educate the audience on some aspect of **alpacas, cats, cattle (beef/dairy), dogs, goats, herpetology, horses, llamas, poultry, rabbits, sheep, small animals, swine.**
 2. be **3:30 minutes or less (1 point deduction per second over 3:30).**
 3. be uploaded by the end of the day, **March 6.**
 4. be the original work of youth in grades 4-13.
 5. be created from October 2022 - March 2023.
 6. include the names of all youth responsible for the creation of the video (credits – names and roles).
- ✓ The youth of the top scoring videos will receive awards at the film festival on March 25 at the Junior Breeder Symposium.
 - ✓ Videos will be scored on educational value, creativity, clarity, pacing, and technical quality (sound, lighting, etc.) – 20 points each, 100 total.

SMALL ANIMAL CLUB OPEN HOUSE

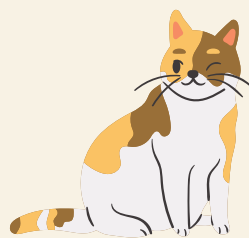

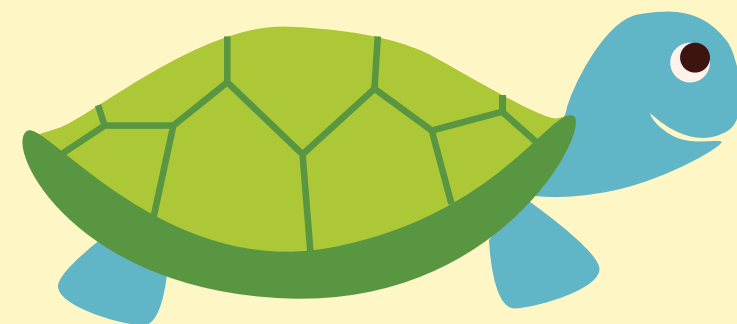

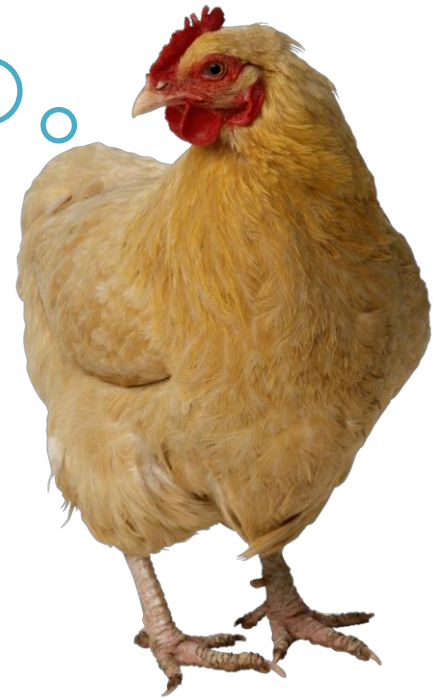




Essex County 4H Chicken Club
